**Synopsis:**

On 10-11-2015 at approximately 1:35 PM, as part of an ongoing investigation, Mendocino County Sheriff's Deputies and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife responded to a residence located in the 42000 block of Crispin Road in Manchester, California.

The purpose of responding to the address was to serve a restraining order, and search warrant.

Upon arriving at the residence, Jerry Moyles was contacted and detained. The search warrant was served resulting in the residence and property being searched. A large amount of live ammunition was located throughout the residence.

Moyles was arrested for being a felon in possession of ammunition and was booked into the Mendocino County Jail where he was to be held on \$15,000.00 bail.
