Synopsis:

On 02-02-2016 at approximately 5:45 PM Deputies from the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to a disturbance at a residence in the 500 block of Acorn Place in Willits, California.

Upon arrival Deputies contacted an adult female who reported her brother, William Williams, was drunk and acting very aggressive. Prior to the Deputies arrival Williams made threats to harm the adult female and demanded entry into her home.

When the adult female refused to open the door, Williams shattered two windows with his fist. The adult female opened the door and Williams grabbed her causing her boyfriend to come to her aid. After a brief struggle the adult female was freed from Williams' grasp.

Deputies located Williams hiding in the residence's backyard and he subsequently attempted to flee by climbing a fence but was apprehended.

As Deputies worked to secure Williams in handcuffs, he was able to kick one of the Deputies in the abdomen. After a brief struggle the Deputies overcame Williams' resistance and secured him in handcuffs.

Williams was arrested for resisting an officer with force, battery, public intoxication, vandalism and violating the terms of his probation.

Williams was booked into the Mendocino County Jail where he was to be held in lieu of \$20,000.00 bail.
