**Synopsis:**

On 02-07-2016 at approximately 2:58 PM Deputies from the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office and the County of Mendocino Marijuana Eradication Team (COMMET) were conducting a search warrant at a residence in the 14000 block of Tomki Road in Redwood Valley, California.

While at the location Jonalec Degallier arrived in his vehicle. Deputies contacted Jonalec Degallier and smelled the odor of marijuana coming from his vehicle.

A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed 46 one-pound bags of bud marijuana inside the vehicle. Jonalec Degallier was arrested for violation of section 11359 H&S and 11360(a) H&S and booked into the Mendocino County Jail where he was subsequently released after posting \$50,000.00 bail.

COMMET assisted by Mendocino Major Crimes Task Force and Mendocino County Sheriff's Deputies conducted follow up investigations and obtained a search warrant for Jonalec Degallier's residence.

On arrival at the residence on Scenic Way in Redwood Valley, Denise Degallier and her two children were contacted.

Deputies observed a loaded rifle leaning against the frame of the front door in reach of the two children standing nearby.

A search of the property revealed two additional firearms in the reach of the children and approximately 401 pounds of bud marijuana in a building next to the residence.

Denise Degallier was arrested for 11359 H&S, 12022(a)(1) PC and 273 PC and booked into the Mendocino County Jail where she was subsequently released after posting \$50,000.00 bail.

The two children were released to family members.
